CHARITY ACTIVITY REPORT Financial Year 2016 - 2017

1. Toribari Yuva Kanchan Club, Siliguri voluntarily undertakes the responsibility of reconstruction of collapsed bridge at Toribari Village. This noble work benefit all the poor villagers residing there and also our monastery, therefore our Trust has donated a sum of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) to this club for the said work.
2. In the month of November and December 2016, a total number of 2500 pieces of note books & stationeries (pencil, scale & geometry box) distributed to students of financially poor background studying in 18 Primary & High Schools and 4 ICDS (Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) is a government programme in India which provides food, preschool education, primary healthcare, immunization, health check-up and referral services to children under 6 years of age and their mothers) in and around Salugara. The total cost of this charity program is Rs. 400,214/-.
3. From 24th February to 15th March 2017, the Trust conducted a charity program where indoor and outdoor sport equipments were distributed to student studying in 19 primary and high schools & 4 ICDS in and around Salugara. Sports equipment includes table tennis board, bats & balls. footballs, cricket equipments, badminton rackets, volley balls etc. The total cost of this charity program is Rs. 314,327/-.
4. We provided financial support of monthly Rs. 500/- each to two destitute person viz. Mr. Rajkumar Biswakarma & Parsuram Biswakarma of Toribari Village, Siliguri. Both of them are the bread earner of their family but they unexpectedly got bed ridden due to untoward diseases.
