## CHARITY ACTIVITY REPORT

Financial Year 2017-18.

### 1) Free distribution of Computer set, printer & computer table to schools:

Computer & its knowledge has become very crucial in this modern times, it has become an important element which we use in our everyday life to make our life easier. It has extremely become important to provide basic computer knowledge to students but the underprivileged students and students in poor villages has always been deprived of such basic rights. The computer and the printer will help teacher enhance their teaching and students also have the benefit of new learning process. Therefore the board member has decided to distribute desktop computer, printer and computer table to schools in nearby villages as a part of annual charity program for this year.

Hewlett Packard (HP) company were contacted & collected quotation for the computer and printer, after board member approved the quotation 26 sets of HP desktop computer purchased at Rs. 11,26,346/- (Eleven lakh twenty six thousand three hundred forty six only) from Redington India Ltd and 26 pcs of HP Deskjet printer purchased from Savex Technologies PLtd which cost Rs. 104,832/-, both the Redington India Ltd and the Savex Technologies PLtd were the national distributor of the HP.

Original Microsoft office Students & Home version 2016 software and 1 year antivirus were installed in these computer sets which cost Rs. 46,710/-.

26 pcs of computer tables were purchased from Bharat Furniture which cost Rs. 66,560/-.

After conducting a ground survey 21 schools nearby Salugara were chosen as the beneficiaries of this charity program.

The distribution program was held on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2017 at a pandal set up at the front yard of Ewam India office. The function was held with the presence of the Trust's President, Vice President, General Secretary, Treasurer, Head of schools, teachers, students and staff of Ewam India. The President Mr. Tsultrim Rinchen Khampa & the Vice-President Mr. Karma Namgyal Bhutia gave a brief introduction of the Trust and the importance & the background of this charity program. The teachers and the students also expressed their gladness to be the part of this program.

Initially 4 sets of computers, printers & tables were allocated to Salugara Govt. High School but the school didn't attended the distribution program despite handing over invitation letter to the Principal himself on 31/10/2017. Therefore out of this four sets, one set was given to Laxmimaya C.S. Primary School and three sets were given to Ewam Nunnery School, Toribari.

2) **Free distribution of blankets to Pilgrims, homeless & beggars:**

Countless numbers of homeless, beggars and poor people suffer tremendously during cold winter nights. Winter is also a season for pilgrims from hilly region of West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim and Bhutan who travels to Boudhgaya and other Buddhist



pilgrimage sites through Siliguri, these pilgrims were mostly poor people from remote locations. As a part of annual charity program, the board member has decided to distribute blankets to these peoples to save them from this harsh winter. 820 pcs of blankets in total were purchased from Golden Amber and D. N. Traders which cost Rs. 762,360/-. On the night of 9<sup>th</sup> January 2018 a team of Ewam India with blankets visited various locations such as NJP railway station, junction Tenzin Norgay Bus stand, Siliguri Government hospitals and other random location and distributed blankets to homeless, beggars and poor people. A total number of 820 poor people were benefited from this charity program.

3) **Financial assistance to poor, handicapped & needy person:**

Mr. Raj Kumar Biswakarma and Mr. Parsuram Biswakarma, who are poor and handicapped and both the resident of Toribari village are being provided with a sum of Rs. 500.00 per month per person as a financial assistance from the trust.
