**REPORT ON CHARITY ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT BY THE
EWAM INDIA CHARITABLE TRUST
FOR THE YEAR 2018-19.**

1) Free distribution of books & stationeries to students:

Under this charity program a total of 2717 student of 22 schools under Dab Gram-I has been benefited directly. With a permission from the Smt. Pradhan of Dab Gram-I Panchayat, Salugara, this charity program was executed on 12th to 14th September 2018. The members and the volunteer of the trust visited 22 schools in this three days and with the consent from the school authority the books & stationeries were distributed directly to each and every students.

The detail contents of the books & stationeries and number of beneficiaries are as follows:

For each pre-primary children: 2 drawing books, 1 coloring book, 1 polo oil pastels (12 colors) & 1 Doms pencil set to 296 children.

For each student of class I to IV: 1 drawing book, 1 math's book, 1 four line note book, 2 note book, 1 doms pencil set & 1 Domsx1 premium kit to the total number of 1309 students.

For each student of class V to X: 2 long drawing book, 2 long notebook & 1 set Natraj Ball pen (5 pcs) to the total number of 1112 students.

The list of schools and number of beneficiaries in each school is attached herewith.

The cost of the books and stationeries distributed is Rs. 498,304.00 (Four lakh ninety eight thousand three hundred four only), for detail please refer the financial account statement attached.



The schools, ICDSs and its students benefited from this charity activities were amongst the most poorest and backwarded section of the community. Majority of the families of these students were unable to afford basic requirements of stationeries to their children for which they solely rely of Government sanctions.

Thus this charity activity serves as an immediate relief to the individual student, their parents and the school administration also. All of the school thanked the trust for this deeds and many sent Thank You note thereafter.

2) **Free distribution of blankets to homeless, beggars & poor people:**

Weather during winter in this region is cold especially during the nights. Many homeless, beggars & poorer section of the people suffer a lot and many lost their lives due to the cold weather. Taking this into consideration a free distribution of blankets to the needy was carried out on 5th January 2019. For this campaign 800 pcs of blankets were purchased and the member and the volunteers on the night of 5th January 2019 visited NJP railway station, Siliguri junction, Tenzing Norgay bus stand and its vicinity. Homeless, beggars & poor people including old aged, handicapped & infant were present in huge numbers sleeping in open area & floor with hardly anything to cover themselves. Total number of 351 blankets were distributed on that night.

On 31st January 2019 the poor people including handicapped and homeless residing in villages nearby Ewam India Monastery were provided with blankets. A total number of 449 people were benefited on that day.

The cost of 800 blankets is Rs. 252,000.00 (Two lakh fifty two thousand only) and the account statement is attached herewith for detail information.

3) **Financial assistance to poor, handicapped & needy person:**

30 years old, Mr. Raj Kumar Biswakarma and 31 years old, Mr. Parsuram Biswakarma, who are poor and handicapped and both the resident of Toribari



village are being provided with a sum of Rs. 500.00 per month per person as a financial assistance from the trust.

Mr. Raj Kumar Biswakarma passed away in the month of June 2018 thereby discontinued the monthly financial assistance from June 2018. Mr. Parsuram continues to benefit from this financial support from the trust.

Similarly 58 years old Mr. Tapan Roy, resident of Adarsha Nagar colony, Siliguri approached this office for financial assistance for his cervical surgery to undertake soon. A sum of Rs. 2,000.00 (Two thousand only) has been provided as a medical assistance to him.

In conclusion, A sum of Rs. 881,087.00 (Eight lakh eighty one thousand eighty seven only) has been received as donation for charity program for the FY 2018-19 & Rs. 759,804.00 (Seven lakh fifty nine thousand eight hundred & four only) has been utilized to carried out the charity activities which directly benefits the part of poorer section of the community. Rs. 5,017.00 (Five thousand seventeen only) has been utilized to acquire printed caps & shirts for staff and volunteers to wear during the charity programs, printing of banner mentioning charity activities, printing of certificate of appreciation to staff & volunteer for their active participation in the programs.

During last year (FY 2017-18) charity program a sum of Rs. 30,551.00 (Thirty thousand five hundred fifty one only) has been utilized in excess (as mentioned in the financial report prepared by CA 2017-18). This excess expenditure has been settled from donation received for charity purposes for the FY 2018-19.

The charity fund balance as on 31.03.2019 is Rs. 85,715.00 (Eighty five thousand seven hundred fifteen only) which will be utilized in the next FY. The charity program this year is also a huge success and a contribution towards making a life of less privileged ones a little easier.
