ANNUAL CHARITY ACTIVITY REPORT

1) FREE DISTRIBUTION OF 3 PLY MASK & SANITIZER FOR FRONTLINE WARRIORS.

Charity Implementation area:

SILIGURI, WEST BENGAL & GANGTOK, SIKKIM.

Total cost of the charity program:

364, 392/- (Three lakh sixty four thousand three

As the Covid-19 pandemic is spreading at a rapid pace and that the medical infrastructure of the country is facing a huge burden with the growing number of people being infected with this deadly virus, it is a moral responsibility of the Non-Governmental Organization to supplement the Government's efforts to fight this pandemic.

The Additional Secretary of Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has on 01st April 2020 wrote to all the FCRA registered Association to seek support in containing and managing this pandemic.

As a moral responsibility of being the charitable trust and in response to the call from the Government of India, the board member has decided to contribute and aid government by supplementing their efforts in our own small way. One of the most important factor in containing the spread of this virus as of now is by implementing the hygienic habits of each and every individual of the nation. Therefore the member has decided to distribute protective face mask and sanitizer to frontline warriors such as doctors, nurses, police personnel, sanitation workers who are tirelessly working days and nights to fight against this ongoing pandemic.

A total number of thirty thousand (30,000) pcs of 3 ply protective mask & one thousand eight (1,008) pcs of hand sanitizer purchased from Harsh Enterprise, Siliguri who provide good quality at the reasonable price. One pcs of the mask cost Indian Rupees 10.50 and a total cost for thirty thousand pcs is Rupees 315,000/- (Indian Rupees three lakh fifteen thousand only). 1 bottle of Hand Sanitizer (100ml) cost Indian Rupees 49.00 and a total cost for one thousand eight pieces is Rupees 49,392/- (Indian Rupees forty nine thousand three hundred ninety two only).

With the permission from Panchayat, the charity program was carried out in the month of April 2020 at the following locality and the beneficiaries are as follows:

1. Chief Minister's Office, Govt. of Sikkim:

10000 mask & 408 pcs of hand sanitizer.

2. Commissioner of Police, Siliguri:

5000 mask & 204 pcs of hand sanitizer.

3. Bhaktinagar Police Station, Siliguri:

2016 pcs mask & 60 pcs of hand sanitizer.

4. North Bengal Medical College & Hospital:

5008 pcs mask & 108 pcs of hand sanitizer.

5. Siliguri Municipal Corporation:

2016 pcs mask & 36 pcs hand sanitizer.

6. Dabgram-I Panchayat, Salugara:

1008 pcs mask & 24 pcs hand sanitizer.

7. Nuns at Ewam India nunnery:

2016 pcs mask & 96 pcs hand sanitizer.

2) FREE DISTRIBUTION OF NIOSH APPROVED V-4400N95 MASK & FACE SHIELD TO FRONTLINE WARRIORS.

Charity Implementation area: SILIGURI, WEST BENGAL & GANGTOK, SIKKIM.

Implementation date: NOVEMBER & DECEMBER 2020

Total cost of the charity program: 787,500.00 (Total Rupees Seven lakh eighty seven thousand five hundred only)

With the growing number of Covid-19 cases and immediate risk to the frontline warriors, the board members of the Ewam India Charitable Trust decided to contribute the protective mask for the frontline warriors such as doctors, nurses, police personnel, sanitation workers & as per special request from the Gangtok Municipal Corporation a good quality face shield for Covid mortality cremators who are tirelessly working days and nights to fight against this ongoing pandemic.

There are numerous brands and qualities of mask available in the market but the board member decided to distribute good quality and most importantly clinically approved mask. Therefore after consultation with the medical experts the VENUS mask which is NIOSH approved V-4400N95 Mask & STUDDS FACE SHIELD was chosen for this charity program.

After consultation with the members a total number of 10,000 pcs of N95 mask & 20 pcs of Studds face shield purchased from Harsh Enterprise, Siliguri who provide good quality at the good price. One pcs of the mask cost 78.75 Indian Rupees and a total cost for 10,000 pcs is Rupees 787,500/- (Indian Rupees seven lakh eighty seven thousand five hundred only). Total cost of face shield is Rs. 8,600/- @ Rs. 430/pcs.

Mr. Dilip Singh, the Chairman of the Siliguri Municipal Corporation has helped the Trust in laying out the plan and figuring out the beneficiaries of this particular program.

With the permission granted by the Dabgram-I Gram Panchayat, this charity program was carried out in the month of November and December 2020 at the following locality:

3) 1ST FREE DISTRIBUTION OF ESSENTIAL RATION TO POOR PEOPLE.

Charity Implementation area: VILLAGES IN & AROUND SALUGARA.

Implementation date: MAY 2020.

No. of Beneficiaries: 300 FAMILIES.

Total cost of the charity program: 149,220/- (One lakh forty nine thousand two hundred twenty only).

Since the Covid-19 pandemic is spreading out of control and spreading across the globe at an alarming rate, the Government of India as a preventive measure to contain the spread of this virus has imposed nationwide lockdown for the last almost three months. The situation still is grim and the government may continue the lockdown if the situation didn't improve.

This pandemic and the lockdown has caused the nation's economic slowdown and the worst affected victims are the poor people, daily wages and labourers who became jobless as the factories & workplaces were shut. Millions of people loss their job and sources of income, there were shortages of food and the reports .

Considering this grim situation the board member has in consultation with the local Panchayat decided to distribute free essential ration to 300 poor and needy people who are worst affected by Covid-19 pandemic. Local Panchayat and their members sorted out the list of poor & most needy people from their locality. Following is the list of ration for distribution for one family:

2 kg Potato

1 pkt salt

5 kg Rice

1 kg Chati

5 kg Atta

The Covid-19 pandemic and the subsequent nationwide lockdown has tremendously affected the lives of entire population specially those of poor people. Labourers and daily wagers lost their jobs & incomes and these poor people faces difficulties in feeding their families. There were many incident evident specially in villages where people faces shortages of food and people are desperately trying to get a basic meal on a daily basis. There were incident where huge number of people gather at a place meal or ration are distributed free of cost.

Considering this grim situation the board member has in consultation with the local Panchayat decided to distribute free essential ration to 800 poor and needy people who are worst affected by Covid-19 pandemic. Similar charity program of distribution of free ration was conducted by Ewam India in the month of May 2020 also. Local Panchayat and their members sorted out the list of poor & most needy people from their locality. Following is the list of ration for distribution for one family:

5 kg Rice

2 kg Chati

5 kg Atta

2 Ltr Mustard oil

In order to follow the Covid protocols a token to receive free ration were distributed to poor and needy people through local Panchayat and members in advance which helps the charity program function orderly and without gathering a large number of people.
